NOTIFICATION SUMMARY

The Grant Office received five notifications of unspent funds in SFY 2020 totaling \$628,805.08.

- Nevada Department of Agriculture reported \$1,949.75 in unspent funds from the National School Lunch Program Equipment Assistance Grants for School Food Authorities FY2017 (CFDA 10.576). The Grant Office determined further action was not feasible due to the expiration of the grant award on September 30, 2019; the funds were reverted to the awarding federal agency.
- Nevada Department of Agriculture reported \$287,571.14 in unspent funds from the FY19 Fresh Fruits and Vegetable Grant (CFDA 10.582). The Grant Office determined further action was not feasible due to the expiration of the grant award on September 30, 2019; the funds were reverted to the awarding federal agency.
- Nevada Department of Agriculture reported \$270,115.98 in unspent funds for the NSLP State Administrative Expense Grant Funds (CFDA 10.560). The Grant Office determined further action was not feasible due to the expiration of the grant award on September 30, 2019; the funds were reverted to the awarding federal agency.
- Nevada Department of Agriculture reported \$54,430.02 in unspent funds for the Team Nutrition Training Grant for Innovative State Training Programs FY2019 (CFDA 10.574). The Grant Office determined further action was not feasible due to the expiration of the grant award on September 30, 2019; the funds were reverted to the awarding federal agency.
- Nevada Department of Agriculture reported \$14,738.19 in unspent funds for the FFY19 Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) grant (CFDA 10.576). The Grant Office determined further action was not feasible due to the expiration of the grant award on September 30, 2019; the funds were reverted to the awarding federal agency.
