





Grant Fit Check

How do I know whether a grant opportunity is a good fit for my organization? It's important to consider various indicators when researching grants and whether or not you are well positioned to apply for a grant opportunity. There are various guiding questions that can be used in a conversation and to conduct a "grant fit check". Below is an example of how an organization might evaluate an opportunity under consideration.

Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act Opportunities

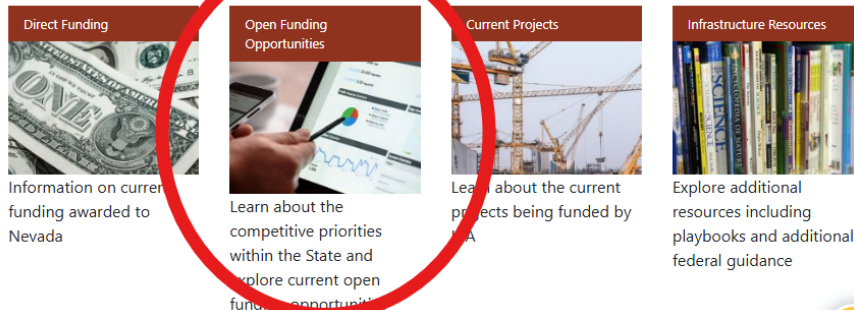
The Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act (IIJA), also known as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), is the largest federal investment in infrastructure and a once-in-a-generation opportunity. Funds are available to:

Rebuild roads, bridges, and trails
Expand access to clean drinking water
Expand broadband coverage throughout the nation
Prepare infrastructure for impacts of climate, cyber-attacks, and extreme weather
Improve ports, airports, rails, and roads to strengthen our supply chains
Create new jobs to continue to grow our economy

To date, this funding has helped with the creation of over 286,000 jobs in Nevada with an investment of almost \$10 billion into private sectors in our state.

OFA offers a centralized hub, in cooperation with the Nevada Governor's Office to provide support to Nevada's stakeholders as they research and apply for these federal funds.

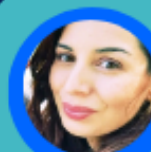

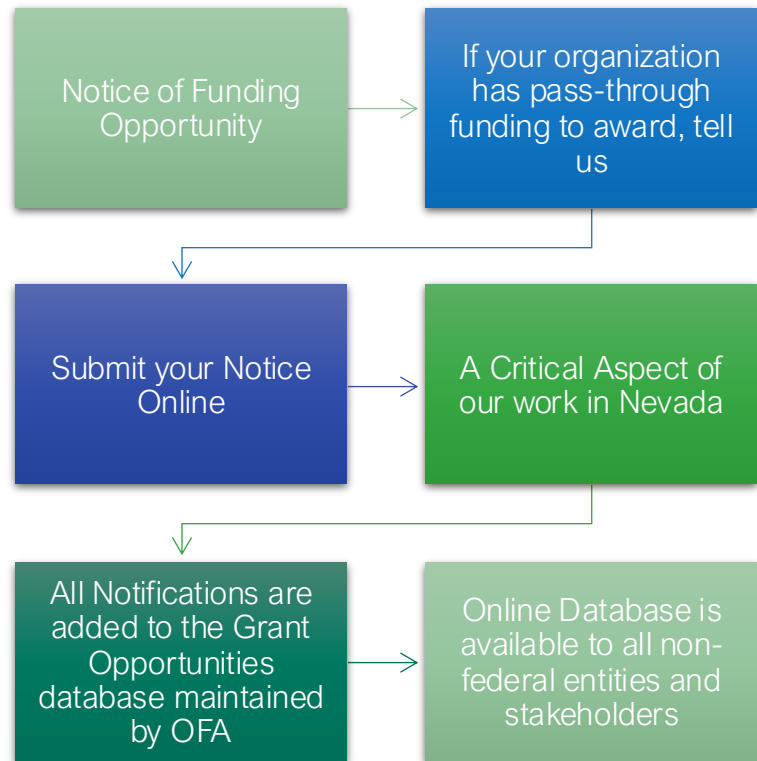

Single Point of Contact & Intergovernmental Review

OMB Number: 4040-0004
Expiration Date: 03/31/2012

- FEDERAL EXECUTIVE ORDER (E.O) 12372
- Also referred to as the Intergovernmental Review
- Purpose is to coordinate in-state grant applications
- Fosters intergovernmental partnerships
- The Grant Application and Submission information (SF-424) will inform the applicant that an Intergovernmental Review is Required, and the SPOC must be notified to comply with the State’s process under EO 12372
- Submit through the OFA online automated form –our team will conduct the review, log, and generate and provide you with the required SAI #

19.	Is Application Subject to Review by State Under Executive Order 12372 Process? Applicants should contact the State Single Point of Contact (SPOC) for Federal Executive Order 12372 to determine whether the application is subject to the State intergovernmental review process. Select the appropriate box. If "a." is selected, enter the date the application was submitted to the State
20.	Is the Applicant Delinquent on any Federal Debt? (Required) Select the appropriate box. This question applies to the applicant organization, not the person who signs as the authorized representative. Categories of debt include



Required Reporting

All state agencies are required to provide the following grant notifications to the Governor's Office of Federal Assistance:

- ☐ Any grant for the state agency applies;
- ☐ Any grant for which state receives, this also includes any change in grant award amounts;
- ☐ Any grant that is closed out, including providing the amount of a grant received by a state agency that is unexpended at the end of the period for which the grant was made.

Notifications are required by NRS 223.480, State Administrative Manual (SAM) 3000, and Nevada Grant Policy "088-003 State Agency Required Grant Notifications" and subject to internal audit.
