

Grant Matching Program

Overview

The Governor's Office of Federal Assistance Nevada Grant Matching Program (GMP) receives \$1,000,000 each state fiscal year to fund up to 50% of a required match for new, competitive federal grant opportunities.

Qualified recipients of the Nevada Grant Matching Program are located in Nevada and are as follows:

- State Agencies
- Local Agencies - "Local agency" means any local legislative body, agency, bureau, board, commission, department, division, office or other unit of any county, city or other political subdivision"
- Non-Profit Organizations
- Tribal Governments

The questions are derived from the list of eligibility requirements. The project must meet all the following requirements:

- The grant is a new competitive federal grant.
- Your organization is the prime recipient of a federal grant.
- Your organization meets the requirements as described in the Notification of Funding Opportunity (NOFO).
- The grant you are applying for is within the scope of your organization.
- Either you have not received the federal notification of grant award (NoGA) **OR** the award date listed on your NoGA is less than 90 days ago.
- A match is required.
- You exhausted all other sources for the required match.
- You need 50% or less of the match requirement.

Process Description

Once you have determined that your project is eligible, the process is simple.





- **Application** - Once you determine that your project is eligible, print the page with the instruction sheet and list of items you will need to fill out the application. It can take up to 2 hours to fill out the application.
- **Independent Review** - The application goes before independent reviewers.
- **Letter of Commitment** - If your application is approved, a Letter of Commitment will be issued. This process, on average, takes up to 10 business days.
- **Grant Award** - After you are awarded the grant, send in the completely signed off and accepted federal grant award.
- **Risk Assessment** - Once the fully executed federal grant award is received, a risk assessment begins.
- **Award Agreement** - With a completed risk determination, the grant agreement is written and sent to you. The Grant agreement has all the reporting requirements outlined in detail. Once returned, we initiate the “check cutting” process and your organization is paid in full.

Other Services

The Governor’s Office of Federal Assistance also assists with grant discovery, grant writing, grant management, grant review, technical assistance, and, of course, the grant matching program.
