This disturbing trend, especially with fentanyl, underscores the urgent need for specialized intervention programs tailored to Hispanic adolescents facing substance misuse and acculturation stressors. CARAS integrates evidence-based practice programs, focusing on strengthening familial bonds and reducing acculturation stress, adapting its strategies to the cultural dynamics of Southern Nevada's Hispanic youth. The initiative also includes a robust marketing campaign to enhance community awareness of the risks associated with Marijuana, Opioids, and alcohol misuse Key objectives of CARAS are: 1. Enhancing Family Communication: Implementing our program to improve intrafamily dialogue and support, essential for youths navigating cultural integration. 2. Increasing Awareness and Education: A culturally resonant marketing campaign will inform the community about how acculturation impacts substance use, emphasizing prevention and available support resources. 3. Building Community Capacity: Training educators, healthcare providers, and community leaders to effectively support at-risk youth with proactive preventative strategies. The expected outcomes of CARAS are centered on reducing substance use risk factors among participants, which will be measured using the SAMHSA GPRA



	reporting to all at initial fallow up and displayed stores. Additional
	reporting tool at initial, follow-up, and discharge stages. Additional
	specific metrics related to substance abuse issues will be collected
	and analyzed by a third-party group to gauge the program's
	effectiveness in reducing opiate and stimulant use and enhancing
	community competence in managing acculturation stress.
	Ultimately, CARAS aims to foster a supportive environment that
	mitigates risk factors while promoting protective factors against
	substance use disorders among Hispanic and other ethnic youth.
